- You will not know which 15 questions are unscored, so treat every question as if it counts.
- Unanswered questions are scored as incorrect — there is no penalty for guessing, so never leave a question blank.
- Schedule at aws.amazon.com/certification by selecting "Schedule an exam" and signing in with an AWS Builder ID.

Content Domains (Quick List)

1. Domain 1 — Cloud Concepts: 24% of scored content, organized into four task statements.
2. Domain 2 — Security and Compliance: 30% of scored content, the single largest domain.
3. Domain 3 — Cloud Technology and Services: 34% of scored content, the largest domain overall.
4. Domain 4 — Billing, Pricing, and Support: 12% of scored content, the smallest domain.

The exam has four content domains with published weightings — memorize the order of weight (Domain 3 > Domain 2 > Domain 1 > Domain 4) so you can triage study time correctly.

Key Terms and Concepts to Memorize

- AWS Well-Architected Framework pillars: Domain 1 covers identifying design principles of the AWS Cloud, including these pillars — know them by name and be able to match a scenario to the right pillar.

- Fixed vs. variable costs and rightsizing: Domain 1 covers cloud economics concepts, including fixed versus variable costs and rightsizing — expect scenario questions contrasting CapEx with OpEx.
- AWS Cloud Adoption Framework (AWS CAF): Domain 1 addresses migration benefits and strategies, including the AWS CAF — know its role in guiding migration planning.
- Shared Responsibility Model: a core Security and Compliance concept distinguishing what AWS secures versus what the customer secures.
- IAM basics: users, groups, roles, and policies — the backbone of Security and Compliance questions.
- Core service categories: compute (EC2, Lambda), storage (S3, EBS), database (RDS, DynamoDB), and networking (VPC) — Cloud Technology and Services is the largest domain, so breadth across services matters more than depth.
- Support plans and billing tools: Billing, Pricing, and Support covers AWS Support plan tiers, the Pricing Calculator, Cost Explorer, and budgeting/alerting tools.

Common Gotchas and Traps

- Do not confuse scored and unscored questions — 50 of the 65 questions are scored and 15 are unscored, but they are indistinguishable during the exam, so answer all 65 with full effort.
- The exam reports pass/fail only, not a detailed numeric breakdown by domain — do not expect to see your exact score per domain during the test.
- Remember the exam explicitly states unanswered questions are marked incorrect — always select an answer, even a best guess, before moving on.
- Watch for questions that test the highest-weighted domains (Security and Compliance at 30% and Cloud Technology and Services at 34%) disguised as simple scenario questions — read carefully for the specific AWS service being described.
- Do not assume in-person testing is the only option — remote OnVUE proctoring is available if a testing center is inconvenient.
- Do not underweight Domain 4 just because it is smallest (12%) — a few missed billing/support questions can still tip a borderline score below 700.

Night-Before Checklist

- Confirm your exam appointment time, delivery method (Pearson VUE center or OnVUE online), and required ID.
- Review the four domain weights one more time: Cloud Concepts 24%, Security and Compliance 30%, Cloud Technology and Services 34%, Billing/Pricing/Support 12%.
- Skim the Well-Architected Framework pillars and the Shared Responsibility Model — these show up across multiple domains.
- Remind yourself: 65 total questions, 90 minutes, 700 to pass on a 100–1,000 scale, pass/fail result only.
- Plan to answer every question — no guessing penalty, but blanks are automatically wrong.
- If testing online, test your webcam, ID, and quiet room setup in advance per OnVUE requirements.
- Get sleep — 90 minutes of sustained focus benefits from being well-rested more than a final cram session.
